## RULES AND REGULATIONS

### **GCCBC IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ILLEGALLY KEPT OR EXHIBITED BIRDS**

1. Entry fee is a donation of \$3.00 per tag with the maximum of \$50.00 per show. Use a separate entry blank for each division.
2. The management suggests using regulation show cages where possible. No cage smaller than a regular shelf cage is permissible (approx. 10" x 10" x 8").
3. All classes are open, except where noted. Show management reserves the right to reject any entry.
4. All birds must be checked into the show hall between 5:00—9:00 p.m. Friday and 6:00—8:00 a.m. Saturday. Judging will commence upon completion of judges' books.
5. No bird will be allowed in the show room except those duly recorded in the books of the secretary.
6. The management reserves the right to make any changes deemed best to add, combine or cancel existing classes. Management has the right to engage additional judges if necessary.
7. Judges' decisions are final. Complaints must be in writing, given to the secretary before show's end and accompanied by \$5.00 deposit as per rules. Should cases arise not covered by rules and show manager, show secretary and superintendent of section will render a decision.
8. Full discretionary power is given the judge to withhold any or all prizes for want of merit and no judge shall exhibit in any section where he or she is the judge.
9. **BIRDS WILL BE ALLOWED FOR SALE IN THE SALE ROOM BY EXHIBITORS AND CLUB MEMBERS ONLY.** However, a \$2.00 fee will be charged for each bird to be sold. The buyer will be given a receipt, the cage tag will be marked "sold" and the entry blank will also be marked "sold". Your cooperation will be appreciated.
10. No cards, signs or display advertising will be allowed on or about the cages before judging. Birds or cages may not be handled. No bird will be allowed out of the cage during the show without the permission of the show manager. No exceptions.

  - 12. On receipt of your entry form and entry fee, the secretary will issue cage tags. Fasten tag on lower left-hand corner of cage front.
  - 13. Anyone joining the GCCBC after September 1 will not be eligible for membership awards for the present year.
  - 14. All young birds must be bred and banded with a closed, traceable club band. No family bands, except in Division E, G, and H.
  - 15. Division award winners must be BRED AND BANDED BY EXHIBITOR, except divisions F, G and H. Put BB on entry blanks to complete for Bred and Banded awards.
  - 16. Bred and Banded awards will only be issued to birds bred by exhibitor and wearing a closed, traceable band, except for SPBE open bands.
  - 17. Unflighted birds are bred & banded with current year, recognizable closed club bands.
  - 18. Flighted birds are old birds. Birds without bands must be entered in the old class.
  - 19. All quarantine birds must have been the property of their owner for NO LESS THAN SIX MONTHS before show date.
  - 20. NO SMOKING WILL BE ALLOWED.
  - 21. Seed should be placed on the bottom of the cages except for American Singers, which are required to use white paper on cage bottom (paper will be supplied at show). NO SEED WILL BE PROVIDED BY GCCBC.
  - 22. Please show proper respect for our judges. During the judging process, remain seated in the viewing areas. Secretary's tables are absolutely off limits to any but show personnel and staff.
  - 23. Best Novice award is given to an exhibitor who has not won a 1st, 2nd, 3rd in section, 3 times at 3 different shows in open competition. Novice exhibitors must add "N" to the section number and class number. He/she must also write the word NOVICE after his/her name on the entry sheet. No novice award will be given if an exhibit does not declare him/herself to be a novice.
  - 24. Birds will be released when judging is completed.
  - 25. All birds must be caged at all times.

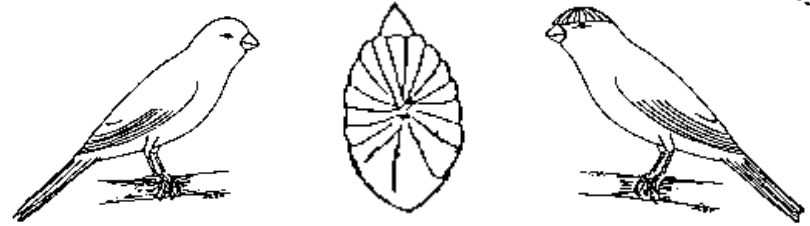
